2026 VENDOR BOOTH CONTRACT

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into by and between the Vendor, its authorized representative, any approved booth-sharing partner(s) whose signatures appear below, and their employees, agents, and independent contractors (collectively, the "Vendor"), and the Cotati Accordion Festival ("CAF"), and sets forth the terms and conditions governing participation in the Cotati Accordion Festival to be held at La Plaza Park in Cotati, California, on August 15 and 16, 2026.

PAYMENT OF RENTAL FEES: All reserved space rental fees must be paid in full (cash, credit card, or check) before August 1st, 2026. If the Vendor fails to pay all the fees at that time, the CAF, at its option, may rent the space to another Vendor. Only written cancellations (NLT June 15, 2026) will be accepted and will be subject to a \$50.00 cancellation fee.

SECURITY AND INSURANCE: The CAF will provide overnight security provided by a bonded security company, in La Plaza Park on August 14th, 15th & 16th, but it is suggested that the Vendor pack everything away that night. CAF will not be liable for theft, loss, or damage of any kind, nor will it provide insurance on any Vendor property. **PLEASE NOTE:** There is no overnight camping allowed on the park grounds.

INDEMNITY AND RELEASE: Vendor agrees to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the CAF, the City of Cotati and the County of Sonoma, from any claims, causes of action, damages, losses, liabilities, costs, and expenses arising out of or in any way connected with the activities of the Vendors at the Cotati Accordion Festival. The Vendor expressly releases and forever discharges the aforementioned parties from any liability for damage, injury, death, or loss of property arising from any cause whatsoever in connection with the Vendor's participation in the Cotati Accordion Festival.

FOOD SALES: Vendors, who prepare, distribute and/or sell food or beverage products hereby agree to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the CAF from any claims or damages relating to the same of such products. Vendors agree to fulfill all California permits and county health regulations. **A COPY OF THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT PERMIT MUST BE POSTED IN CLEAR VIEW AT THE EVENT.**

CLEAN UP: Vendor agrees to clean and restore the rented space to its prior condition. If said Vendor fails to leave the rental space in clean condition, the CAF may assess the Vendor for reasonable cleaning costs. Vendors are responsible for their own trash, waste water, and any other liquid waste.

PARKING RULES: On Friday, the 14th, Vendors may load-in beginning at 11:00am. On Saturday the 15th, Vendors may load-in through the gates beginning at 6:00am and must have their vehicles out by 9:00am. There is no load-out until after 7:00pm on Saturday or Sunday. Cars left inside the gates during performances will be towed.

WATER AND SODA RULES: Food vendors are permitted to sell bottled water and soda.

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MATTERS NOT COVERED IN THIS AGREEMENT: Any matter not specifically addressed in this Agreement shall be determined at the sole discretion of the CAF.

APPLICABLE LAW, VENUE, AND ATTORNEY'S FEES: California law shall govern this agreement. In the event of any dispute or litigation arising under this contract, the prevailing party shall be entitled to reasonable attorney's fees. Venue for any action arising under this Agreement shall be exclusively in California.

FORCE MAJEURE: The CAF shall not be liable for cancellation, postponement, or modification of the event due to circumstances beyond its reasonable control, including but not limited to severe weather, natural disasters, government orders, public health emergencies, labor disputes, or other unforeseen events. In such circumstances, refund policies shall be determined at the sole discretion of the CAF.

RECYCLING: Vendors shall comply with all recycling, composting, and garbage disposal requirements established by the Cotati Accordion Festival and Recology. Vendors must also follow the directions of Recology's recycling signs & assistants throughout the event. Food vendors using disposable food service products are required to use certified compostable food ware in accordance with Recology's guidelines.

EXECUTION: This Agreement shall become binding upon execution by both the Vendor and an authorized representative of the Cotati Accordion Festival.

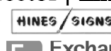
